**M**athew Wynge of Banburye in the Countie of Oxforde Taylor  
 being of perfect memorye (thankes be to god) do make this my last will and  
 Testament in manner and forme followinge. Inprimis I bequeathe my soule to  
 god my maker and to Ihesus xpi ste my redemer and my boode to be buyed in  
 Banburye thurthe ward. Item I give and bequeathe to the poore of Banburye  
 some fillinges. Item I give and bequeathe unto ffulte mye eldest some the  
 of my house wher I dwell in and twentie poundes in money. Item I give to Thomas my  
 stand some thirtene poundes. Item I give to John my thurd some fowte fillinges. Item  
 I give to Robert Chamberlayne my sonne in lawe some poundes. Item I give to Johane  
 my daughter twentie fillinges. Item I give to the children of ffulte mye eldest  
 some aforesayed as followeth. To Anne hys eldest daughter some poundes a februed  
 and three payer of sheetes. Item I give to Dorcas hys second daughter three poundes  
 a well bedd three payer of sheetes and the least brass pott. Item I give to Mary hys  
 yongest daughter three poundes three payer of sheetes a bolster a coverlet. Item  
 I give to Mathewe hys sonne three poundes the middle brass pott the finest sheete  
 and a blanket. Item I give to John Wynge the sonne of Thomas Wynge my stand  
 some aforesayed fowte fillinges. Item I give to Debora Wynge the daughter  
 of John Wynge my thurd sonne and to John hys sonne twentie fillinges a peere  
 Item I give to John Nicholls the sonne of John Nicholls my sonne in lawe twentie  
 fillinges. Item I give to William Wynge the sonne of James Wynge my sonne  
 some twentie fillinges. Item I give to Thomas Chamberlayne the sonne of  
 Robert Chamberlayne my sonne in lawe twentie fillinges. Item I give to the  
 children of Richard Gullins viz. To John two fillinges six pence. To Thomas  
 twelve pence and to Johane twelve pence. Item my will is that yf any of my children  
 thildren shall decease that then the legacies as I have bequeathed to them shall  
 remaine to the surviving brotger or sister or the thildre or children to be equallye divided  
 amongst them. Item my will is that James my fourth sonne shall not repaye the  
 ffifte fillinges wher he owes me but be acquitted of the same. Item I give  
 unto Anne my wife thirtie poundes of lawfull english money to be payed to her  
 by three severall payments within the space of one yere after my decease. My will  
 is that she shall also have the free and quiet use of my hall house some chamber  
 varden and stables, one litle horse in the same, and also the use of all the rest of my house  
 holdstiffe unbequeathed in my will so longe as she shall continewe wydowe and no  
 longer. Last of all I give the rest of my goods unbequeathed my debts being payed  
 and ffmerrall discharged unto my children viz. To ffulte Thomas John James  
 and Johane to be equallye divided amongst them. Item I make my three sonnes  
 ffulte and Thomas executors of this my last will and testament. And I appoynt  
 my loving ffrendes M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Whatley M<sup>r</sup> Nicholas Eden and M<sup>r</sup> John  
 Nicholls my overseers of this my last will and I do give them three fillinges a  
 peere. And yf any doubte or ambiguitie do arise concerning this my last will  
 and testament my will is yt to be determyned and ended by these my sayed  
 overseers or twoe of them. And herunto I have set my hand and Seale the  
 daye and yere aforesayd. The make of Mathewe Wynge. These being

I do make and ordayne my last will and testament the eighteenth  
daye of October in the yere of our Salvation one thousand five hundred  
and fourtene in manner and forme followinge. Inprimis I do commend my soule  
into the handes of god the father hoping of eternall joyes in the heavens not  
for any good dedes or desertes of my owne but for the merittes and thronyng  
of the passion of my onlie Lord and Saviour Christe Iesus god the sonne by  
the sanctification of the blessed spiritt god the holie ghost. Secondly I do  
commend my bodye unto the earth wherof yt is hoping of a joyfull resurrection  
and finall redemption of the soule and bodye for entrie in the heavens. Thirdly I do  
dispose of my goodes as followeth. Inprimis I give and bequeathe unto my daughter  
Andrey Baudrey the somme of tenne poundes in ready money. Item I give to  
the paroch of the parische of Colenham twentie shillings wherof tenne shillings  
to be given and delivered at my buryall and the other tenne shillings to  
remaine in a stocke for the said paroch. Item I give to Raphe Baudrey my  
godsonne tenne shillings. Item I give to Robert Eaton my godsonne five  
shillings. Item I give to every other godchilde twelwe pence. All the  
rest of my goodes not before disposed I give and bequeathe to Johane Baudrey  
and Andrey Baudrey my wife and daughter whom I make executor  
joyntly of this my last will and testament. Lastly I nominate and  
ordayne Reginald Brown clerke and william Jacob yeoman Executors  
of this my last will, not doubting but that they wilbe aydyny and helping  
to my abovenamed executoris not only in disposing of my goodes and paymyng  
debtys but especially in the bmsnes of marriage comfayning my sayde  
daughter for her good and profit. And hoping of their favour I rest  
disposid of earthely thynge in full hope of heavenly for entrie. Given at  
my dede the daye and yere abowritten. The Seal and marke of Raphe
